

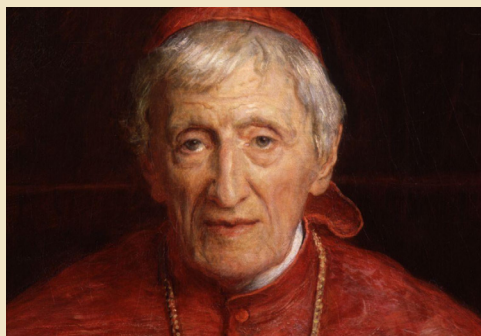
2018 SUMMER SEMINARS
